





Subjects of arbitrations instituted in 2024:




Subjects of mediations instituted in 2024:




#### Number of Arbitrators\*:

#### Gender\*:





#### EXPERT EXAMINATION



The expert examinations concluded in 2024 occurred in the average duration of 15 months, until the delivery of the expert report.

Of the expert examination proceedings ongoing throughout 2024, even that were not concluded or initiated in 2024, **32%** deal with engineering matters, **32%** deal with accounting matters, **18%** deal with economic evaluation, **15%** deal with real estate appraisal matters, and **3%** deal with tax matters.



# CHALLENGE OF ARBITRATORS



- •There were presented 10 challenges of arbitrators throughout 2024.
- •Of these 10 challenges, in **6** the arbitrators spontaneously resigned, in **2** the challenges were closed for reasons other than the challenge; and in **2** were constituted a Committee to judge the challenges.
- •Of the 2 cases that the Committee were constituted, **1 was deemed** valid, with the removal of the arbitrator; and **1 was deemed groundless**, with the maintenance of the arbitrator.
